Program Policy

A “program / event “ is a planned interaction between the library staff and the program participants for the purpose of promoting library materials, facilities, or services, as well as offering the community an informational, entertaining, or cultural experience.

Programming includes such activities as story times, films, STEM, summer library programs for children, speakers, authors, etc.

Participation in Library programs is open to all. Due to space restrictions, on rare occasions, some programs may be open to Fort Edward Residents first, then open to general public.

The director, in conjunction with the board, will establish a budget and goals for programming to facilitate the effective implementation of this service.
